Old Business:

The Auction was set for March 16th at 6:00 pm at the Community Complex. The building is donated or given at a reduced rate to schools, but because we are raising funds, the charge will be \$200.00.

The cost per person for the meal will be **\$25.00**. Children are welcome to attend with you – OR – they can stay with a sitter next door. The cost will be **\$10.00** per child where they can have pizza and game night.

The meal will be a pasta bar, bread, salad and dessert with tea, water, lemonade, and coffee.

Each classroom will choose a theme or maybe two for baskets. Rather than have a whole table to auction off, there will be several baskets of themed items. This way, more people will have an opportunity to bid. Depending on what a classroom collects, they could have 1 – 5 or more baskets worth at least \$30.00 each.

We are encouraging parents to try to get donations from folks with whom they do business. We want to avoid you giving the items and then buying them back. We also want to sell tickets to and invite people out side the school.

We are in hopes of obtaining large ticket items to auction off as well as the baskets. If you have contacts with people who provide destination get-a-ways, golf packages, artwork, landscaping, or any other high end items, that would help us to entice more people to attend.

The teachers will again be auctioned. It is so enjoyable to spend a day with the children away from school.

If you have an item that does not fit a theme, we can auction it separately if it is a more costly item.

Youth Center:

As many of you know, we were looking into the Youth Center as a possible second campus for CAC. The lease option has been taken off the table and replaced with a sealed bid option. We were going to pursue that, but the minimum bid was more than we were comfortable with. We will wait to see what happens with that facility, but are still raising money for future growth at CAC and would welcome any donations toward that cause. The Auction funds raised will go toward the acquisition of a gym/additional facility.
